The Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) was developed by the United Nations and is the basis behind the Occupation Safety and Health Standards (OSHA) Hazard Communication. It creates a consistent system of classifying hazardous chemicals on labels and safety data sheets through standardization. On March 26, 2012, the U.S. (OSHA) published the final rule to revise the Hazard Communication Standard to align with the GHS.

Hazard Communication Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1910.1200 (b) (5), suggests labeling for certain chemicals is not required. Furthermore, Section 19.10.1200 (b) (5) (iii) states this exemption applies to any food or food ingredient when they are subject to the labeling requirements of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) or the Department of Agriculture (USDA). The FDA regulates dietary supplements and ingredients within, as food.

Therefore, all M2 Ingredients, Inc. Organic Mushroom Powders listed, whether sold individually or within a blend, are exempt from an accompanying Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
